

If you are not registering online, you may use the form on page 11 to **Register** and **Order Event Tickets**. Event tickets will not be mailed to you – they will be provided when you check in at the registration table at the convention. Golfer's Note: You may pick up your registration package at the Hotel on Friday.

The order form and a check or money order payable to the MD22 Convention Committee are to be sent to the *PCC Gary Burdette, MD22 Convention Treasurer, 22711 Mount Ephraim Road, Dickerson, MD 20842*. **Payment must accompany ticket orders.** Orders without payment will be returned. No credit cards are accepted with mail-in registrations.

The form may be used by an individual registrant or a couple purchasing tickets or registering together. **Do not use this form for more than two people.** Forms with more than two names will be returned. Orders may be grouped and covered by one check (preferably a club check); however, **each participant (up to two) must be on a registration form.**

Tickets – Will be provided for the 'Friendship Garden' Lunch, Multiple District Banquet, 'Seeds of Leadership' Breakfast Buffet, District Luncheon, the Victory Breakfast, and Miniature Golf. All ticket requests **must be received by April 10, 2026**.
